2010 TRAINING CALENDAR

Key to course dates and times: the following indicates the likely mode a course will operate in;

- When there is just one date listed, this generally indicates a full day course.
- Introduction to Scouting/Rovering seminars are three hour duration, except when coupled with a Skills Training activities. They are then all day.
- When there is a comma in the date, this generally indicates a multi day, non-residential course e.g. 13, 17.
- When there a stroke in the date, this generally indicates an overnight course e.g. 5/6.
- When there is a dash in the date, this generally indicates a multi day and night residential course e.g. 4-6.

Starting times for courses will depend on the type of course. This will be confirmed in the letter you will receive approximately two weeks prior to the course starting date. As a general indication, the following can be considered:

- A single, full day course will generally commence around 9.00 am.
- A multi-day, non residential course will generally start around 9.00 am each day.
- A multi-day and night course will generally start around 7.30 pm on the first evening.
- A multi-night course will generally start around 7.00 pm each night.

Due to the nature of some of the courses, these times will not necessarily be correct in all instances and will be confirmed in your welcome letter. If you have any queries, you should contact the Service Centre responsible for your course.

Synopsis of Training Courses:

Level 1 Food Handling - (Follow Workplace Hygiene Procedures THHGH501B)

This is a one day course that is a hands on introduction to identifying and preventing food hygiene risks in typical Scout situations. It covers legal requirements, food storage & handling, personal hygiene, temperature control, cross contamination and cleaning.

Level 2 Food Handling - (Implement Food Safety Procedures THHBCA11B)

This one day hands on course for prospective Food Safety supervisors covers how and when food safety can be at risk and how to implement policies to ensure food is handled safely. The level 1 Course (or an equivalent) is a pre-requisite to this course.

Training of Trainers – Training Methods

This is a one day course that provides you with the basics of presenting information in an open forum. It covers the basics of how to put together session plans and materials and how to go about preparing yourself to deliver this material. This will assist you in many of your roles – as a Section Leader, it will give you a range of alternative ideas on how to deliver material to the young people you provide training for. For District Leaders, it helps in providing better sessions at your District Training Meetings (Wandarrah, Seonee, etc.). For Leaders assisting on Training Courses, it will provide you with the basics for delivering sessions to young people and adults.

Training of Trainers – Training Techniques

This is a two day course that provides you with additional opportunities to expand on basics of presenting information in an open forum. It also provides additional information and opportunities to practice preparing the material you might use to support your deliveries. This course also looks at how to use a range of different training support equipment. The assistance is an extension of what the Training Methods course provides.

Training of Trainers – Personal Leader Adviser

This is a two day course that provides you with the skills necessary to assist new Leaders in particular, achieve their Certificate of Adult Leadership. It also provides ideas to support other leaders in achieving their Woodbadge. This course covers a whole range of skills commencing with having that initial meeting with the new Leader, through to finalising their appointment requirements. It also provides the skills to work in a one-on-one environment that can assist Section and District Leaders in the small group environments that they face.

Training of Trainers – Assessor

This is a two day course that provides you with the capability to enhance your skills in determining the competence of a person completing a particular skill. It will provide you with a range of ways that you can determine how skilled a person is. This will assist you in many of your roles – as a Section Leader, it will give you a range of alternative ideas on how to assess the skills of the young people you provide training for. For District Leaders, it helps in providing better ways of reviewing and providing feedback. Also, for Venturer Leaders it provides the skills to enhance the outcomes of the Venturer Leadership and Unit Management courses.

Training of Trainers – Training Leadership

This is a two and a half day course that provides you with the capability to enhance your skills developing and running activities and courses.

YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID WORKSHOP

In order to be able to give Mental Health First Aid to a young person, first aiders need some basic knowledge about mental health issues to allow them to recognise the problem that may be developing. The following mental health issues which are common in young people will be covered in the training:

- Depression,
- Anxiety disorders,
- Substance use disorder,
- Psychosis,
- Eating disorders, and
- Non suicidal self injury.

This training does not teach people to be therapists. Rather, it teaches how to recognise the symptoms of mental health issues, how to provide initial help and how to go about guiding a person towards appropriate professional help. A five step action plan will be detailed out during the training for responding in an appropriate way to an individual who is requiring support.

The training will be presented by Loren Miller, who has 10 years experience working in the youth services sector in counselling, youth work and community development. Loren is a trained YMHA facilitator.

(FIDGETS, DAYDREAMS and) BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP

Why are children so fidgety and difficult to engage in activities? Why do some daydream and avoid tasks? Why are some aggressive and why do they bully each other? Managing children's behaviour involves understanding the triggers for behaviours. This workshop will explain children's behaviour and sensory processing and will provide techniques and activities to assist leaders manage their group and enable children to fully participate in the Scout program.

Susan Stork-Finlay is an accredited paediatric occupational therapist providing consultancy and training. She has vast experience working with children with behavioural issues.
